- You shall not use profanity or offensive language toward MWW personnel or other site guests.
- You, by your participation, accept the inherent risks of which a prudent person is or should be aware of when using the site (including when participating in or on amusement rides and other attractions). You should consider this participation in a responsible manner and with good judgement, particularly if you have a health or medical condition, are pregnant or have other physical limitations. Patrons with medical conditions are responsible for assessing whether they can participate. You must seek medical advice if uncertain.
